	Competition Rules
Article 1:	Contestant registration and video must be submitted no later than July 1, 2021.
Article 2:	Registration information must be truthful or the contestant will be disqualified.
Article 3:	Contestants may sign up for one or more of the following accordion categories: D) Diatonic Accordion P) Piano Accordion
Article 4:	Contestants will register under their age group in one or both of the accordion categories: • Up to 11 years of age • 12 to 16 years of age • 17 to 25 years of age • 26 to 35 years of age • 36 to 59 years of age • Seniors 60 and over
Article 5:	Contestant grants permission for the publication of any photographic or video materials created during the championship competition.
Article 6:	 Contestants qualifying for the Finals: The highest two scores in each age group within each accordion category (piano and diatonic) will move on to the World Cup Finals (24 potential finalists).
Article 7:	Performance should be up to 4 minutes long. Timing is of essence. Going over the time restriction, will result in points deducted.
Article 8:	Contestants must play a polka or waltz (or medley) of their choice.
Article 9:	Judges will be evaluating performances using the following criteria: • Up to 20% - Accuracy of execution • Up to 20% - Musical interpretation • Up to 20% - Technical complexity • Up to 20% - Rhythmic delivery • Up to 20% - Overall appearance and presentation of the contestant
Article 10:	Contestants are encouraged to perform in the traditional costume of their country of origin OR in attractive casual attire. Marks will be deducted for inappropriate clothing (e.g. track suites, T-shirts, shorts, etc.).
Article 11:	The contestant in the grand Finale with the highest overall score across <u>ALL</u> accordion categories will be awarded the 2021 World Cup on the Accordion Polka Championship grand prize
Article 12:	All Contestants will receive a Certificate of Achievement recognizing their highest score.
Article 13:	 Video submissions must meet the following criteria: The image must be clear and in focus The audio must be clear and not distorted Video should be in MP4 format Video should be recorded in 720p or 1080p resolution Video should be in landscape orientation Contestants must use only 1 stationary camera Each song must be filmed in one take and not edited in any way The sound of the accordion should be acoustic and not altered in any way (no special effects, looping, midi-programing, etc.) The MP4 File should be named as follows: YourName_SongTitle.mp4 The MP4 file must be submitted via shareable cloud link such as Dropbox or Google Drive no later than July 1 2021 Button Akordion Rocks Club has the right to request a new video for any reason
